

Jehovah's Witness Greek Lesson

Rev 1:11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

Here it is with Strong's numbers:

I underlined the Greek letters Alpha and Omega. Here are the words: egw eimi to a kai to w

Here is a breakdown of some of what the NWT leaves out:

legoushv – from the root word “logos” which means “word” – it means “to speak, saying, etc.”
egw eimi – pronounced “ego imee” – “I am”.

to – pronounced “Toe” – it is a definite article “the, this, etc.” (neuter gender)

a – Alpha – 1st letter of the Greek alphabet

kai - pronounced “kahee” - “And”

to – pronounced “Toe” – it is a definite article “the, this, etc.” (neuter gender)

w – Omega – Last letter of the Greek alphabet

o – Same word as “to” but it is the masculine gender.

prwtov – pronounced “protos” – “first in time or place”

kai - pronounced “kahee” - “And”

o – Same word as “to” but it is the masculine gender.

escatov – “eschatos” – “last in time or place”

1 Tim 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Strong's Numbers: And <2532> without controversy <3672> great <3173> is <2076> (5748) the mystery <3466> of godliness <2150>; God <2316> was manifest <5319> (5681) in <1722> the flesh <4561>, justified <1344> (5681) in <1722> the Spirit <4151>, seen <3700> (5681) of angels <32>, preached

<2784> (5681) unto <1722> the Gentiles <1484>, believed on <4100> (5681) in <1722> the world <2889>, received up <353> (5681) into <1722> glory <1391>.

Hebrews 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

Strong's Numbers: But <1161> unto <4314> the Son <5207> he saith, Thy <4675> throne <2362>, O God <2316>, is for <1519> ever <165> and ever <165>; a sceptre <4464> of righteousness <2118> is the sceptre <4464> of thy <4675> kingdom <932>.
